This program supports careers in our community. Culinary students work in some of the restaurant businesses within the community. The Bay House's chef works as a mentor and helps employ current and graduated students of the culinary program. The Grill 1646 works with students to help them practice on -the-job running of a restaurant the first Tuesday of every month during the school year.

Students compete at state and national SkillsUSA in many technical and leadership competitions (culinary arts, commercial baking, speech, job interview, job demonstration, cake decorating, restaurant service, customer service, t-shirt design, pin design, and quiz bowl). Every other year students also compete in a culinary competition at Cook Around the World in Orlando, FL against other culinary schools around the country.
