

# Taft 7-12 Grading Information

Parents and Students,

Taft 7-12 has an on-line reporting system for grades. To access the Gradebook Login go to <https://lincoln.k12.or.us/students/>. If you need a parent Gradebook login or information about this gradebook grading process or final grades, please contact the counseling office at 541-996-2115.

## **Grading Scale:**

At Taft 7-12, all students will be required to earn a minimum of a “D” or better in order to pass the course. All assignments and assessments will be graded on an “A, B, C, D and F” scale. The course grading scale is as follows:

A = 90% to 100%

B = 80% to 89%

C = 70% to 79%

D = 60% to 69%

F = Failed Course

See the teacher’s specific course syllabus for information about incomplete assignments, late assignments, and retake policies. If a student fails a course, they may work with the individual teacher on an “Incomplete Plan” or school counselor to repeat the course the following semester, on-line, or during summer school.

## **High School (9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>) Grading Periods:**

Courses are composed of two 9 week terms. Each term will award 0.5 credits. Each year there will be four 9-week terms. Progress reports will be mailed home every 9-weeks and final grades will be posted onto transcripts at the end of each term.

## **Middle School (7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>) Grading Periods:**

Students will be enrolled in a Math, English, Science and Social Studies course for the entire year. Each year there will be four 9-week terms. Progress reports will be mailed home every 9-weeks and final grades will be posted onto transcripts at the end of each term.
